The Colorado Thunderbirds AAA hockey organization is pleased to be one of the top hockey youth organizations selected to host a 2010-2011 SuperSeries Tournament at the 96, 97, 98 and 99 birth years. The tournament will feature only the top AAA teams across North America. The tournament will consist of 6 teams with each team receiving a 6 game guarantee. The tournaments will take place December 3-5, 2010 (99s), December 10-12, 2010 (96s & 98s), February 19-21, 2011 (97s). The site for the events will be Big Bear Ice Arena in Denver, CO.

Each team will play a round robin of 5 games. After the five game preliminary round robin each team will play a final 6th game as follows: 1 vs. 2, 3 vs. 4, and 5 vs. 6.

Each team will play two games on each day of the event weekend for a total of 6 games. Please plan to fly into Denver International Airport on Thursday evening prior to your event weekend. Games for the 96s and 98s will commence at 8:00am Friday and conclude at 4:00pm Sunday. Games for the 97s will commence at 9:00am on Saturday and conclude by 3:00pm Monday. Games for the 99s will commence at 9:00am on Friday and conclude by 3:00pm Sunday.

The goal for the tournament is Most Games (each team plays 6), Most Minutes (17 and 15 min stop time), Lowest Cost (no gate fees, Sponsored), Top 20 Teams invite only This is a different kind of tournament. In order to attract the best you need a different format and we have it!!

All tournament games will be governed by USAH rules.

All teams play 6 games guarantee

First four games will be 17 minute stop time periods. The final two games will be 15 minute stop time periods.

Negotiated hotels less than \$79 include breakfast and a complimentary room for every 15 booked by your team.
