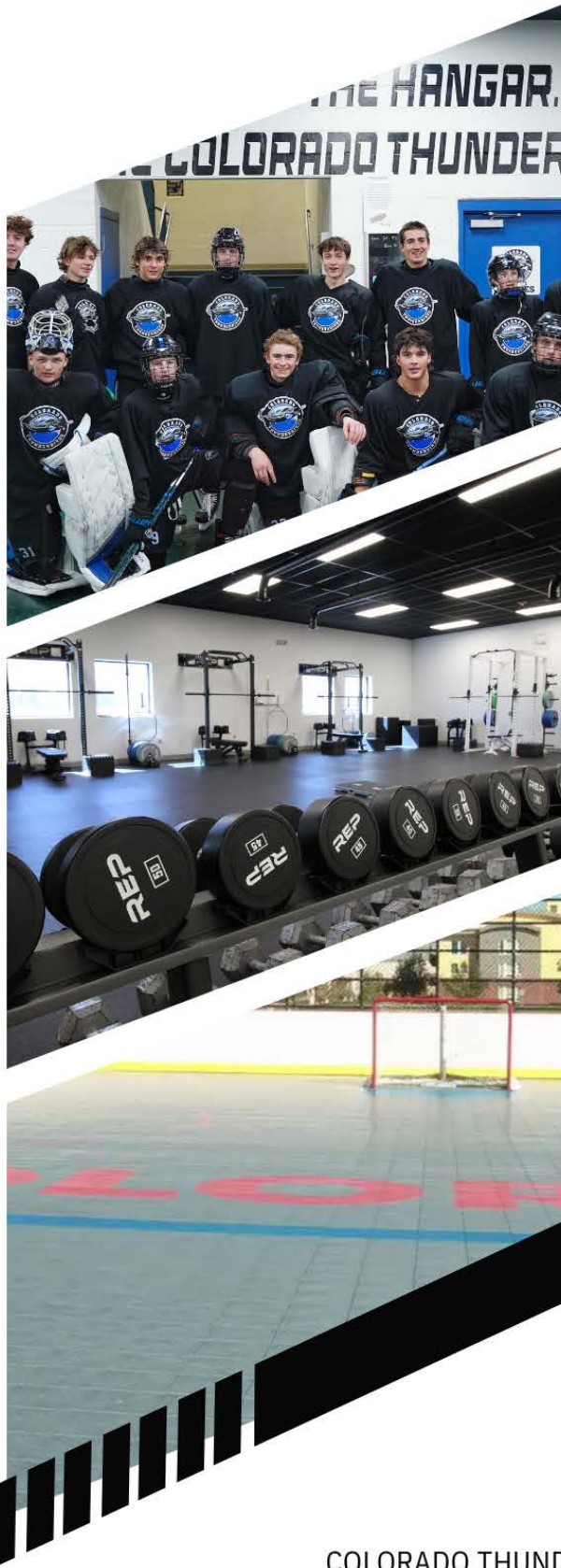

THE HANGAR at BIG BEAR ICE ARENA

8580 E Lowry Blvd, Denver, CO 80230

The Hangar is the proud Home of the Colorado Thunderbirds. Equipped with a full gym and five brand-new, custom locker rooms for each of our Tier I teams this facility is designed to most closely replicate the performance environment our players can expect to see at the junior, collegiate and professional levels.

THE PERFORMANCE DEN

The Hangar includes access to The Performance Den, a state-of-the-art indoor training facility equipped with squat racks, platforms, free weights, assault and cardio bikes, recovery room, TRX bands and more. The Performance Den is home to the Thunderbirds off-ice training program and comes equipped with a 40-yard turf run, connected televisions and provides active views of our North Rink.

THE INLINE SHEET

Aside The Hangar's north wall is a full-size, enclosed inline hockey rink. This rink doubles as an outdoor shooting gallery for the Thunderbird organization and sees dozens of players use it to sharpen their shots before practices and games, weather permitting.

18U, 16U & 150 AAA LOCKER ROOMS

18U ROOM HIGHLIGHTS

Built to replicate a premier junior room, the 18s walk directly out to our north rink. Custom stalls with luxury logo seats cover player bench storage. Players face a widened corridor room with a 65" TV, lineup whiteboard, dry stalls, refrigerator and stick rack. The room is equipped with brand-new showers and restrooms, private to the 18U roster.

16U ROOM HIGHLIGHTS

The 16U room closely mirrors the 18's layout, with a wider floorspace that makes room for a solo support beam in the center. Individual stalls, bench storage and seating focus on the player infotainment center with a connected TV, enlarged whiteboard and hanging shoe stalls. New private showers and bathrooms are attached.

150 ROOM HIGHLIGHTS

In the footprint of our original 18U room in the late 2000s, the 15s room features a vaulted ceiling and walks out to south rink. Our widest midget floorplan provides ample space, as is equipped with all entertainment & snack amenities the 18 and 16s have.



14U & 130 AAA LOCKER ROOMS

14U ROOM HIGHLIGHTS

Individual player cage stalls allow for gear to breathe and dry, custom printed chairs add a level of comfort, and a 75in TV pairs with an oversized whiteboard... and for style, the room is equipped with color-changing LED's for a unique walk-out experience on game day.

130 ROOM HIGHLIGHTS

Our 130 room is the first look our youngest players get at what it feels like to have your own team room. This room is equipped with everything our 14's have, with the minor change being that the LED's exist inside player cages and our goalie stalls sit on a separate wall.



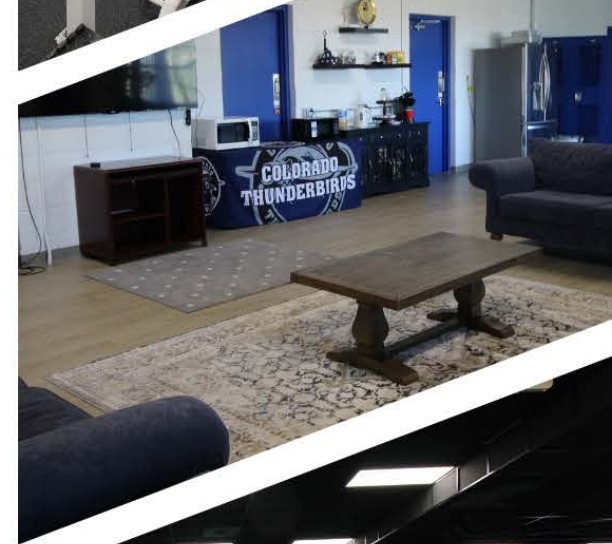
PERFORMANCE DEN and #TBIRDFAMILY LOUNGE

THE PERFORMANCE DEN

The Hangar includes access to The Performance Den, a state-of-the-art indoor training facility equipped with squat racks, platforms, free weights, assault & cardio bikes, recovery room, TRX bands & more. Home to the TBird off-ice training program, it comes equipped with a 40-yard turf run, connected TVs & North Rink views.

#TBIRDFAMILY LOUNGE

The TBird Family Lounge is a private room that sits above both of our rinks at The Hangar. The room boasts a dedicated study area with desks for players and family members alike, foosball and ping pong tables, couches to watch TV or Livebarn, coffee and refreshments as well as storage for things schoolbags, baby-bags, or anything else you carry with you to and from the rink!

OPENING WEEKEND

To open up the season, all the Tier I teams will participate in a unique high-performance weekend to kick off the season. Opening Weekend is an opportunity for parents to meet the coaching staffs along other Thunderbird families, receive all the team gear/apparel for the season and participate in high tempo and fun skill development practices to start the season off. High Level guest coaches typically come in to help run the on ice sessions to kick the season off with a bang! During opening weekend the Thunderbirds host their Association Parent meetings, and coaches will have their season kick off meetings with their parents.

THE SMOKER

The *SMOKER* is a training camp style experience where all teams (130-18U) come together to challenge their physical strength and endurance. The *SMOKER* is a half day event where teams are pushed to their limit physically, participate in their first mental performance session and then all come together to compete in the Thunderbird Olympics, where players form groups from members across all teams to compete in fun and competitive team building competitions together.

STRENGTH & CONDITIONING

Players participate in 1-2 strength and conditioning sessions each week at the Performance Den. The focus of these sessions is athleticism, building strength and injury prevention.

WEEKDAY PRACTICES

Each week teams participate in high tempo, competitive 60-75 minute team practices. Team practices will always incorporate some element of skill development focusing on relevant Habits, Concepts or Details. Teams all work to build on the foundation of *THE THUNDERBIRD WAY* which entails 8 core concepts that every Thunderbird player or Team needs to know and execute to be successful at the next level.

GOALIE DEVELOPMENT

Each week our goalies get two on ice touches with our Goalie Coach Sergey Liulchuk. In addition, Thunderbird Goalies participate in weekly goalie only video sessions as well as monthly 1 on 1 goalie development meetings with Coach Sergey.

VIDEO & ANALYTICS

Each player will have access to the hockey analytics platform TPE (The Prospect Exchange) featuring products that allow players to evaluate, network, and advance their game. Head coaches will also utilize the platform for individual and team video sessions.



TIER I ELITE HOCKEY LEAGUE



The Colorado Thunderbirds Hockey Club is a proud Tier 1 Elite Hockey League (T1EHL) member. The league is the nation's premier amateur hockey league, featuring more than 22 organizations stretching from coast to coast. With significant visibility, top-level talent, and elite coaching often coming from the upper levels of professional hockey, the T1EHL boasts the ability to move young, talented players to organizations such as Major Junior, Tier I Junior Hockey, NCAA Hockey, NHL, and other professional leagues.

Additionally, Thunderbirds will host at least one Youth T1EHL Showcase Event in Denver, CO each year.

ON CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT
