



16U Colorado Thunderbirds Hockey Fact Sheet

Team Fee: \$11,200

Team Fee Breakdown:

- Off Ice Training - \$750
- Video Analytics Package - \$400
- Game Play (Tournaments fees, Refs, Ice etc) - \$4,600
- Locker Room Fee - \$500
- Club Fees (Coaches, Practice Ice, Admin Etc) - \$4,950

Equipment Package: \$1000

Travel Fee: \$1500 per trip up to 9 out of town trips, \$13,500 total

Payment Plan:

- \$25,700 (\$25,450 if paid in full by September 1, 2026)
- Deposit: \$2,500 (due when selected for team)
- Payments: After the deposit of \$2,500 is paid, \$2,500 is due on June 1st and then 7 equal payments of \$2,957.14 per month are due on the first of each month from August 1, 2026 to February 1, 2027.
- Custom Payment Plans available upon request

Refund Policy In the case of a mutually agreed upon departure:

If a player leaves on or before August 15 - Full refund minus non refundable deposit of \$2500
Between Aug 16 and Sept 15 - 80% after non refundable deposit of \$2500
Between Sept 16 and Oct 15 - 60% after non refundable deposit of \$2500
Between Oct 16 and Nov 1 - 40% after non refundable deposit of \$2500
Between Nov 2 and Dec 1 - 20% after non refundable deposit of \$2500
Any time after Dec 2 No Refund will be given

Registration insurance is offered at registration for injuries or illness at your expense, refunds not provided for injuries

Travel:

- Midget 16U travel together as a team.
- Up to 9 out of town trips are included in the Team Fees. This includes expenses on the road such as flights, hotels, transportation, food and other miscellaneous expenses, but does not include team building events like sporting events, mini golf etc.
- If Team travels more than 9 out of state trips, and/or advances to Districts and/or Nationals, equal share of travel expenses for the coaches and Team, including event fees, will be billed to the parents after the trip in addition to fees listed above.

Equipment Package:

- Equipment package is included in the Club fee (hockey bags are separate)
- Equipment will be sized and ordered by W. Team Sales. Players are responsible for any additional quantities or upgrades.
- Equipment package includes practice jersey and socks, game jerseys and socks, pant shell, gloves, and duffle bag, helmet decals, long sleeve shirt, polo, and workout attire.

Practices/Dryland:

- Practices: Approximately 90-100 hours of practice time over the course of the year. Average 3-4 times per week during the weekdays (pending game schedules) plus practices or games on weekends
- Dryland: Approximately 60-70 hours of strength and conditioning training over the course of the year. Average 3-4 times per week
- Weekly Goaltending only practices as well as goalie coach attends weekly practices

IQ Development:

- 30 games/team professionally analyzed in The Prospect Exchange video analysis tool.
- Team video mandated on every road trip, and once a week at home
- Players individual video is cut to show their individual shifts and analytics
- Players populate highlights in their own individual google folder to be shared with scouts and coaches

Games:

- 55-65 Games (excluding States, Districts and Nationals)
- Tier 1 Elite League, www.tier1elitehockeyleague.com
- Local games and a showcase played in state
- Up to 9 out of town showcases or events
